"Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately the leprosy left Him.
- Luke 5:13

In Mark's parallel account, he states that "Jesus [was] moved with compassion, [and] stretched out His hand and touched him," - Mark 1:41. What an amazing compassionate act Jesus did, He touched a leper! We know Jesus didn't have to touch him; He only had to say a word to heal him, but he chose to show this leper love in a way he probably never felt before.
